## Children's Peace Summit Thursday 21 September

To celebrate International Peace Day, and our 30th birthday, we are hosting a Children's Peace Summit at mac Birmingham (<https://macbirmingham.co.uk>), on Thursday 21 September. We are inviting nine schools to bring eight Key Stage 2 pupils and two members of staff to the Summit. Children will discuss peace, and together, we will come up with a pledge and a communique - a message to decision-makers in Birmingham and the West Midlands about what children would like to see happen in our region, to build more cohesive communities.

During the day we will be exploring peace through four themes:

- Inner peace
- Peace at school
- Peace on the streets
- Peace in the world

We will be joined by guests who will help us facilitate the day including Ray Douglas from Gangology and representatives from BeatFreaks.

There is no cost for schools to attend the day as we have raised funding to cover the costs of the event.

Four schools have already booked, so there are five slots available. We will operate a waiting list if the event is oversubscribed.
